



**SINGLE TICKET  
(METRO – TRAIN -RER)**

**2.55 €**

(+2.00 € for NAVIGO EASY card)

A single ticket (Metro/Train/RER) is valid on all railway network lines (except Orlyval, airport stations served by RER B, and the Orly Airport station on Metro Line 14).

**A journey will now cost you €2.50, regardless of your destination, even if you're traveling to the other side of the Île-de-France region.**



**SINGLE TICKET  
(BUS - TRAM)**

**2.05 €**

(+2.00 € for NAVIGO EASY card)

Taking the bus or tram? Your journey will cost €2, regardless of your destination.

The Bus-Tram Ticket is valid only on bus and tram lines.

**If you transfer between RER and bus, for example, you will need 2 separate tickets.**

**(ZONE 1 – 5)**

(except access to airports)

The Navigo Day Pass allows you to travel unlimited throughout Île-de-France for an entire day.

It provides access to all modes of transportation (bus, metro, train-RER, tramway, and T Zen, except Orlyval).

**PARIS VISITE PASS**

It provides access to all modes of transportation (bus, metro, train-RER, tramway), including airport access, and offers discounts at Parisian sites and monuments such as the Grévin Museum, Les Invalides, and the Palace of Versailles.

**NAVIGO WEEKLY PASS**

With the Navigo Weekly Pass, you can travel unlimited within the zones you select. It allows you to use all modes of transportation in Île-de-France: metro, RER, bus, tramway, and train – excluding the Orlyval line, SNCF reservation-based lines, and Optile special fare lines.

The Navigo Weekly Pass can be purchased through the « [SNCF CONNECT](#) » or Île-de-France Mobilités app or loaded onto a Navigo pass card (available for purchase at stations and ticket offices for €5). It is available for purchase starting the Friday before the week of validity and until Thursday of the same week.

- Self-service terminals are present in stations with your bank card. Coins are accepted at all ATMs (notes are not accepted).
- Ticket counter: Sunday: 9:30 a.m. – 12:50 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. – 16.15 p.m.  
Monday to Saturday – 6:00 a.m – 12:50 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. – 19:50 p.m.

### **Free trips for children:**

- For children under 4 years old, travel is free on the entire Ile de France transport network.
- They travel for free everywhere on the Metro, RER, Bus, and Tramway provided they do not occupy seats.

### **Get 50% discount on tickets in the following cases:**

- Children from 4 years old to less than 10 years old.
- Groups of at least 10 young people under the age of 16 and their accompanying person\* or pupils from middle and high schools, including the final year, travel in groups of 10 and who are accompanied by a teacher\*. This discount is not valid on buses and trams. The accompanying person must have the sworn statement duly completed.

### **Dogs and animals:**

In trains & RER you can be accompanied by your pet for free if:

- It is small ( $\leq$  6kg)
- It is placed in a container less than 45cm
- The other travelers do not object. Guide dogs are accepted free of charge on trains, metros, trams & buses.

### **Traveling with your bike:**

- You can travel with your bike on the RER and Transilien lines at no additional cost:
- Saturdays, Sundays, and public holidays all day
- Monday to Friday before 6:30 a.m., between 9:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. and after 7:30 p.m. (between peak hours)
- Bicycles are not allowed on the other metro lines, buses, trams (Except on metro line 1 and on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays).
